**Purpose of the treatment**

**Legal basis, nature of the data and consequence of the lack of communication, methods of treatment**

**Recipients or categories of recipients to whom personal data can be communicated**

**Retention period**

Personal data will be stored for a maximum duration of 10 years from the last invoicing and / or until the conclusion of the contractual relationship.



**Rights of the interested party**

The interested party has the right to obtain from the Data Controller confirmation that it is or is not undergoing treatment of personal data concerning him and in this case has the right to:

- obtain access to personal data, request rectification, cancellation, limitation or oppose their processing;
- to receive personal data concerning him / her in a structured format that is commonly and automatically readable by automatic device and to transmit this data to another Data Controller (data portability);
- be informed of the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling;
- revoke the consent at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the treatment based on the consent given prior to the revocation;
